As a student, you will not be able to care for patients who have tested positive for COVID19 or Patients Under Investigation (PUI) for COVID19, additionally you will not be able to participate in an aerosolizing procedures no matter COVID status.

Before your first clinical shift

1. Fit Testing - You may need to be fit tested for an N95 mask to wear during patient encounters over 1 hour in length or if you choose to wear N95. You must follow the current PPE guidelines related to use of N95, please see above link. Questions contact your clinical instructor. You will need to complete a medical questionnaire to be fit tested. See you can start email for instruction about where to get fit tested.
2. You will also need to go to the badging office to get your student badge. Please call the badging office at 410-601-9767 prior to the day you plan to arrive to obtain your badge.

While in Hospital

1. Upon entrance to the hospital, you will be screened. If you are ill, you will not be able to enter the building.
2. To expediate screen, consider enrolling in Get Well. Click on link www.lifebridgehealth.org/checkin
3. You will be expected to follow the PPE guideline as listed above while you are in hospital.
4. You will be responsible to store your PPE and bring with you during your clinical experience according to PPE guidelines.
5. Please maintain social distancing while moving throughout hospital and follow posted directions.
6. As a student, you will need to park in Pimlico Lot unless otherwise noted per the handbook.

If you have COVID Exposure or Symptoms During Your Rotation

1. Immediately get tested at a local Urgent Care or PCP – vaccinated or not.
2. Then you must then call 410-601-5900 to report the test results and be cleared to return to clinical.
