

VSP's Investigative Assessment, offered virtually using Zoom, is an assessment option for a consumer to more closely identify a vocational area. The assessment results can be utilized for further exploration with a consumer's counselor or through a more comprehensive assessment in the future.

ASSESSMENT SPECIFICS

This assessment is exploratory in nature and includes:

- Assessment of interests, temperaments, and work preferences
- Individual's knowledge of career information
- Job seeking and keeping skills
- Learning style
- Career exploration activities

REPORT CONTENT

- Vocational needs (excluding the use of academic and aptitude information)
- Evaluator observation throughout the process
- Vocational strengths (to the extent possible)
- Transferable skills
- Vocational accommodations/assistive technology considerations
- Summary of results
- Recommendations

ELIGIBILITY

- Minimum 2nd grade reading level
- Access to Zoom technology via device with a camera I.E., smartphone, tablet, laptop, etc.
