


#### **PARKING**

- On the day of your visit, park in the surface lot located at the intersection of W. Belvedere Ave. and W. Northern Pkwy.
- These hyperlinks provide the driving instructions to the parking lot using phone apps:
  - Google maps (link works with iPhones and Androids)
  - Apple maps (link works with iPhones)
  - Waze (link works with iPhones and Androids; copy link and choose "open in Waze" option)
- Upon arrival, proceed to the parking lot entrance (see Map).
  - At the automatic barrier arm gate (see Photo A on next page), push the button to obtain a ticket and enter the parking lot.
  - You may park in any of the unmarked spots within the parking lot (see Map).
  - Bring the parking ticket with you.



## LOCATING THE PEDIATRIC MOTOR DEVELOPMENT LAB


- After you park, take the crosswalk toward the Schoeneman Building (see Map).
- You will see a blue awning/umbrella above the entrance (see Photo B).
- Enter the automatic glass doors of the Schoeneman Building (see Map, Photo C).
- Walk past the check-in desk on your left until you find the elevator (see sketch to the right).
- Take the elevator to the first floor.
- Once you reach the first floor, exit the elevator and take a seat in the waiting area (see Photo D).

- A staff member will arrive shortly to escort you to the Pediatric Motor Development Lab.
